- Color 1: bear arm*
- Color 2: bear tummy, muzzle and inner ear*
- Color 3: remainder of bear*
- Color 4: Santa hat*
- Color 5: scarf - use variegated*
- Color 6: hat outline - dark red*
- Color 7: scarf outline*
- Color 8: hat trim*
- Color 9: trim outline*
- Color 10: bear outline and details*

*I have tried to leave flexibility in the design to allow for individual color choices. I also wanted to keep the outline for the hat and the scarf in sequence as often times I was able to use the same color of red to outline both the hat and the scarf! For*

*the fur trim on the hat, I preferred to outline in a medium shade of soft blue. Grey is also an option if you prefer. Likewise, on my stitchouts I used dark brown rather than black for the bear outline and details. ☺*

*NOTE: Embird software has read my dark red for the Santa hat outline as sable brown. It should be a dark shade of red.*
