

From The Needle Of: Anne
FS Garden Pearls Lace
9 Lace Embroidery Designs (including sample)

- Tested using 2 sheet of fabric like wss
- Use 12 point needle and the same thread for lace base in bobbin, then bobbin thread for details.
- Designs were created with Embird and were sewn on Kenmore 19001 4x4 hoop, tested in sew format.
- Do not resize these designs in any way, as you will loose stitch quality.
- You may rotate, and mirror designs , Combine designs to fill your hoop.
- Slow machine down if necessary.

**Tip: It is recommended that you clean your bobbin area and replace your needle often. Start with a fresh needle.*

- Gather your Supplies

Fabric Like WSS, Thread colors of your choice, bobbins, needles, pins, small scissors, ribbons if desired.



GP Lace Bow @8032 stitches







- Lace (use the same thread in your bobbin)
- Leaf Stitching (bobbin thread)
- Flower (bobbin thread)

Sewn on 2 layers fabric like WSS



Stitch in any color you like!

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<p><i>GP Lace Corner 3 @8287 stitches</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Lace (use same thread in bobbin)</i> • <i>Leaf Stitching</i> • <i>Rings</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>GP Lace Border 3 @12665stitches</i> • <i>Lace (use same thread in bobbin)</i> • <i>Leaf Stitching</i> • <i>Rings</i> • <i>Flowers</i>

	
<p><i>Stitch pieces together using zig zag stitches catching each edge..</i> <i>@ 2.5/.05 repeat if necessary</i></p>	<p><i>Then pin lace to fabric, straight stitch, repeat with a narrow lightening stitch to seal fabric edges and help with fabric frays.</i></p>
	<p><i>Trim fabric from back side, being careful not to cut through lace, rinse well... air dry, iron if necessary.. Enjoy..</i> <i>Ideas: May be used freestanding for napkin rings, or attach to fabric for doilies, napkins, placemats, towel borders, tablerunners....etc...</i> <i>Stitch in any colors you like!</i></p>

Pictured pillow: 2 borders stitched with ribbon lacing

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By topstitching each straight edge to fabric, trimming fabric, these may be also used as inserts

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
