Tiny Flowers

10 tiny flower designs and 1 sample


- Tested using medium cutaway backing
- Use 12 point needle and bobbin thread.
- Designs were created with Embird and were sewn on Janome 350, Jef format.
- Make necessary hooping adjustments for your machine.
- Do not resize these designs in any way, as you will loose stitch quality.
- You may rotate, and mirror designs , Combine designs to fill your hoop.

*Tip: It is recommended that you clean your bobbin area and replace your needle often. Start with a fresh needle.

FF6 63.1x64.5mm	FF7 73.3x37.0mm	FF8 91.2x84.8mm	FF9 77.3x74.6mm 4638 stitches	FF10 65.6x43.4mm
Colors: 1. Wick 2. Flowers and Leaves, 3. Outlines	Use metallic thread on wicking for a fun effect.	 FF sample 13.4x13.4mm 357 stitches	Add 3mm crystals to flower centers or along the vines if desired.	Stitch in any color combo you like.
