Testing:

Designs were created with Embird

An EDR file is a color palette for Embird users, it is unnecessary for other softwares, otherwise please refer to color chart included.

Testing sewn on Janome 350/Pfaff C4

Fabrics:

Stabilizer used Medium tear away backing.

Clear Sulky Topping if needed per project.

Fabric: Testing on broadcloth, Projects purchased baby bibs.




Threads:

40 weight embroidery thread used in the upper, bobbin thread used in the bobbin. Dark thread colors- Use same color in bobbin for best results

Needle:

12 point sharp needle.

Design Information: 2x2
Use any thread color you like

Pic'd above Baby Bibs.

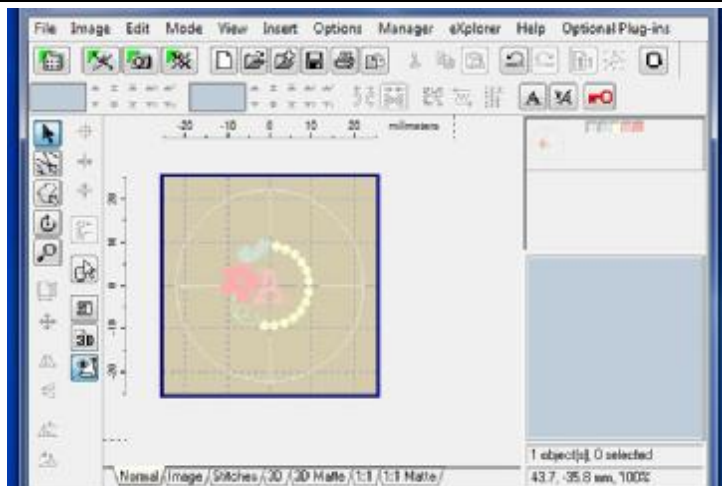
Pic'd above in the Lower center of the photo, you can see the frame 2 sample design sewn for a tiny tag. Add a ribbon to attach or place how you like.



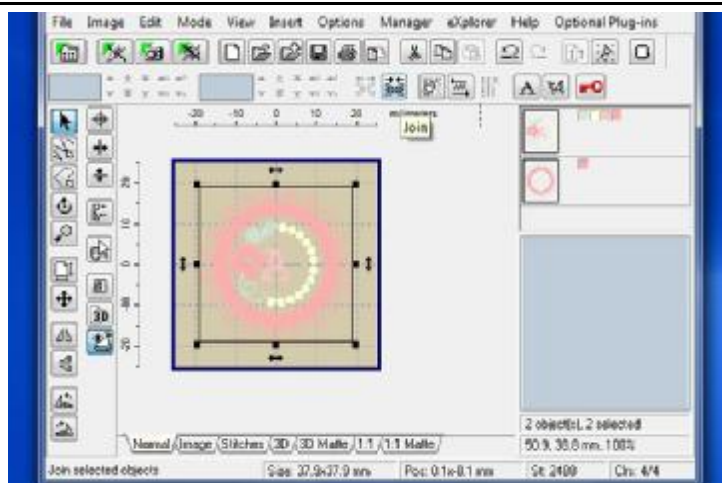

Very Brief Basic Combination Software Example Using Embird



Open 7/8 inch Button Up Design, Bring Into Editor.
Delete the basting stitch- the first color.



Merge the frame design of your choice.
Join designs to make your new combination file.
Save under a new name, example 0290FramedA.....
