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CRAYON HOLDER











Supplies List







- Water soluble stabilizer (not the plastic kind)
- Compressed batting
- Embroidery Thread
- Fabric for top & fabric for lining
- 1 x Press stud
- 1 x decorative button for flap
- Note pad 11cm x 15cm (4.5" x 6")
- Wax or pencil crayons







TIPS & INSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- It is best to read the INSTRUCTIONS before you sew
- Fabric facing RIGHT SIDE UP UNDER HOOP or DOWN UNDER HOOP means that when you have placed the bottom fabric UNDER the hoop & you turn the hoop the right side up the bottom fabric should be facing right side UP or DOWN according to the said direction in the instructions
- Sewing STEPS in the PDF Instructions do not coincide with the sewing STEPS of the pattern. The bullets in each STEP of the PDF will be relatively close to the pattern steps on your flash drive or usb stick of your embroidery machine
- Use colour THREAD to match your fabric. Most of the patterns requires only one colour thread. I use the same colour thread on the top & in the bobbin
- FABRIC quantities varies in size of the project & according to your choice of fabric changes you make to your project
- Many of the COLOUR STOPS in the pattern are for step changes
- CUT OFF as close as possible (even if you sometimes snip the stitches) to your zigzag stitching & the batting stitching so that you don't have excess fabric & batting sticking out of your final satin stitching
- DO NOT REMOVE YOUR WORK OUT OF THE HOOP TILL IT IS COMPLETED
- Once you have completed a panel only cut the larger unwanted threads with a scissor and then singe gently with a lighter flame the fluffy unwanted threads (don't hold the flame too long against the satin stitches or they will burn)

<p>NOTE BOOK POCKET PANEL</p> <p>Step 1: Place water soluble stabilizer in hoop & sew placement line</p>	<p>Step 2: Place compressed batting over placement line & stitch down</p>
	
<p>Step 3: Cut off excess batting close to stitch line</p>	<p>Step 4: Place top fabric right side facing up over batting & stitch down</p>
	
<p>Step 5: Sew pattern & straight placement line for note book pocket</p>	<p>Step 6:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sew placement line for pocket • Fold fabric in half & place folded edge against straight placement line making sure you have covered the whole note pad pocket & tape down • Stitch down note book pocket
	
<p>Step 7:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Place bottom fabric right side facing down UNDER hoop & 	<p>Step 8: Cut off excess fabric from top & bottom of hoop close to zigzag stitching</p>

<p>stitch down</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zigzag panel 	
	
<p>Step 9: Finally satin stitch panel & remove from hoop</p>	<p>CRAYON PANEL</p> <p>Step 10:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow steps 1 - 5 of note book pocket panel
	
<p>Step 11:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For crayon pocket sew straight placement line • Sew placement line for pocket • Fold fabric in half & place folded edge against straight placement line making sure you have covered the whole crayon pocket & tape down • Sew down crayon pocket • Sew partitions for crayons • Zigzag base of crayon pocket 	<p>Step 12:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only cut off excess fabric close to zigzag stitching at base of crayon pocket • Satin stitch base of crayon pocket • Sew placement line for second crayon pocket • Fold fabric in half & place folded edge against straight placement line making sure you have covered the whole crayon pocket & tape down • Stitch down
	
<p>Step 13:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Place bottom fabric right side 	<p>Step 14: Finally satin stitch panel & remove from hoop</p>

<p>facing down UNDER hoop & stitch down</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zigzag panel 	<p>FLAP</p> <p>Sew Flap following steps 1 - 5 & 13 -14</p>
	
<p>Step 15: Place panels as shown & with an ordinary sewing machine zigzag the vertical edges together (not sandwich style)</p>	<p>VIEW OF OUTSIDE OF HOLDER</p>
	
<p>Step 16: Stitch on decorative button</p>	<p>Step 17: Stitch on press stud</p>
	
<p>Place half of note pad in pocket with other half ready to draw on</p>	<p>You can put the note pad inside the pocket with extra crayons. Enjoy!</p>
