**Testing:**

Designs were created with Embird

An EDR file is a color palette for Embird users, it is unnecessary for other softwares, otherwise please refer to color chart included.

Testing sewn on Janome 350 & Pfaff C4

**Fabrics:**

Stabilizer used: 2 layers of WSS (WSS aka: Wash n' Gone, Vilene, H2o etc)

Fabric: Thinner fabrics suggested.

My bookmarks were prepared on Satin fabric with broadcloth backing.

You could use decorative fabrics for your backing.

**Threads:**

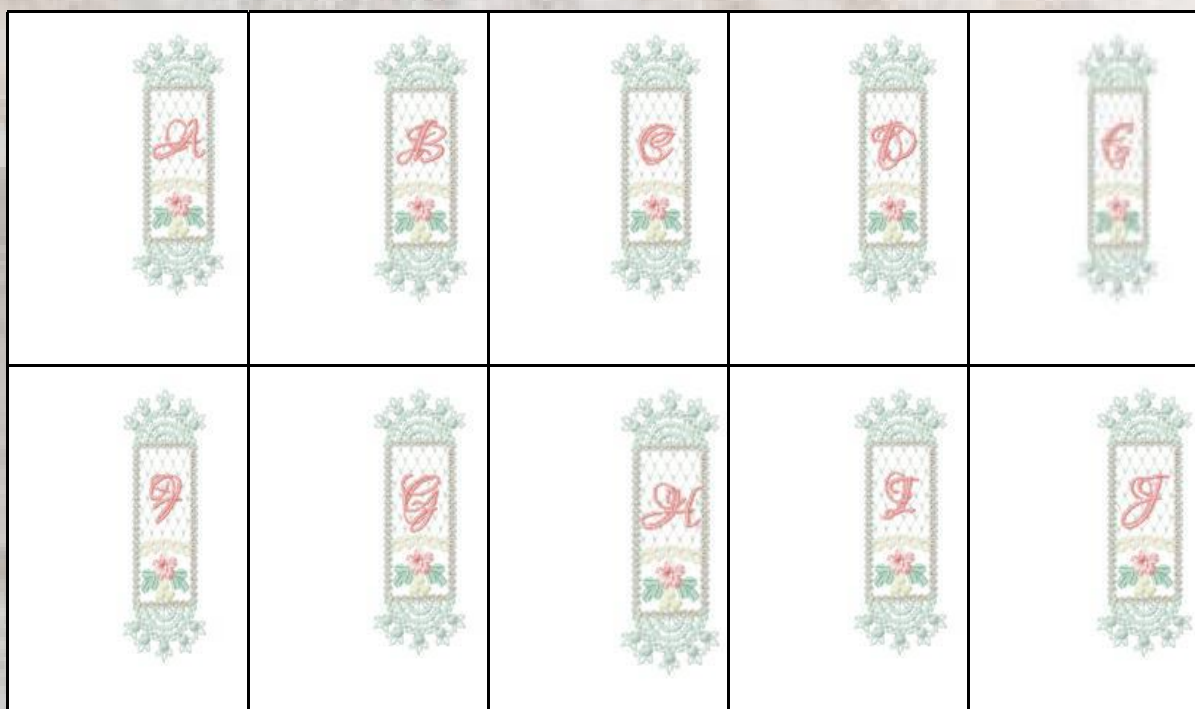
40 weight embroidery thread used in the upper, bobbin thread used in the bobbin.

















Colored laces- Use same color in bobbin for best results

**Needle:**

12 point sharp needle.

**Design Information: 4x4 sizing**





## Embroidery Design Instructions

<p>Hoop 2 Layers of WSS.</p> <p>WSS aka: Wash n' Gone, Vilene, H2o etc</p>	
<p>Begin with the Embroidery of the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch for the majority of the lace portion.</p>	
<p>After sewing the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch, remove hoop to place fabric on top of the WSS over the lace area portion.</p> <p>Pin fabric in place, making sure to keep the pins out of the way of the sewing area.</p>	
<p>Embroider the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch to tack your fabric to the designs area.</p> <p>After the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch has been sewn, remove hoop to trim excess fabric being careful not to cut through the laces. (shown trimmed)</p>	
<p>Continue embroidery using colors of your choice.</p> <p>After you have sewn the initial, stop to add backing fabric, see below....</p>	

Before sewing the 2<sup>nd</sup> to last stitch, the design will allow for you to add a backing fabric.

Remove hoop and Place fabric on backside, pinning from topside.

\*\*\* This fabric will be visible on the backside, so if you are using a decorative print, keep the pretty side up Or you may use plain fabric as I have.



Replace hoop and sew the 2<sup>nd</sup> to last stitch to tack the back fabric together.

Once tacked, remove hoop to trim excess fabric being careful not to cut through the laces. (shown trimmed)



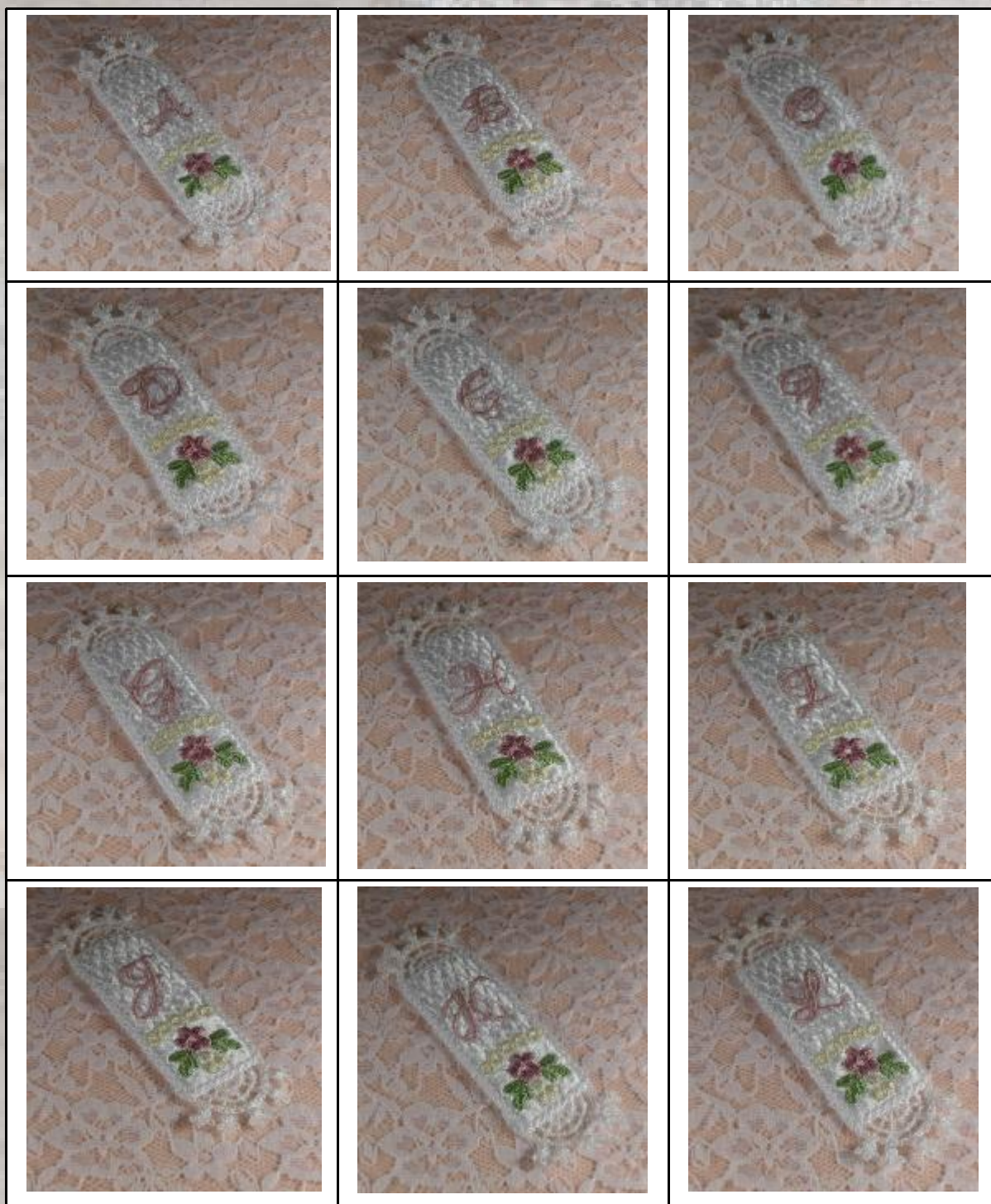
Finish the last stitch for the final lace bordering.

When complete, remove from hoop, Trim away excess wss and soak well in water to remove the wss.

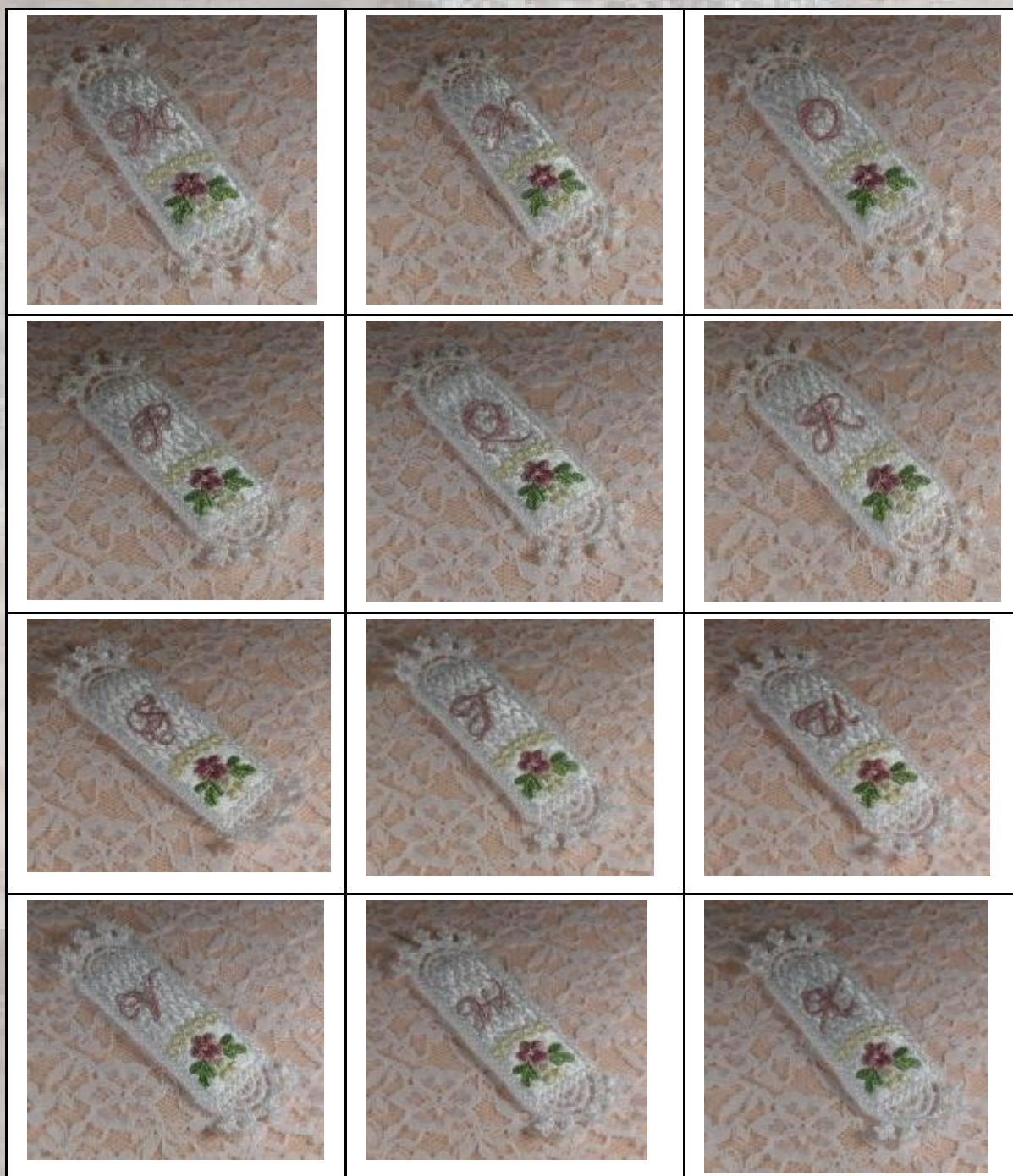
Allow to airdry thoroughly before decorating.
