

CAVELL'S BLANKEY IN A BAG

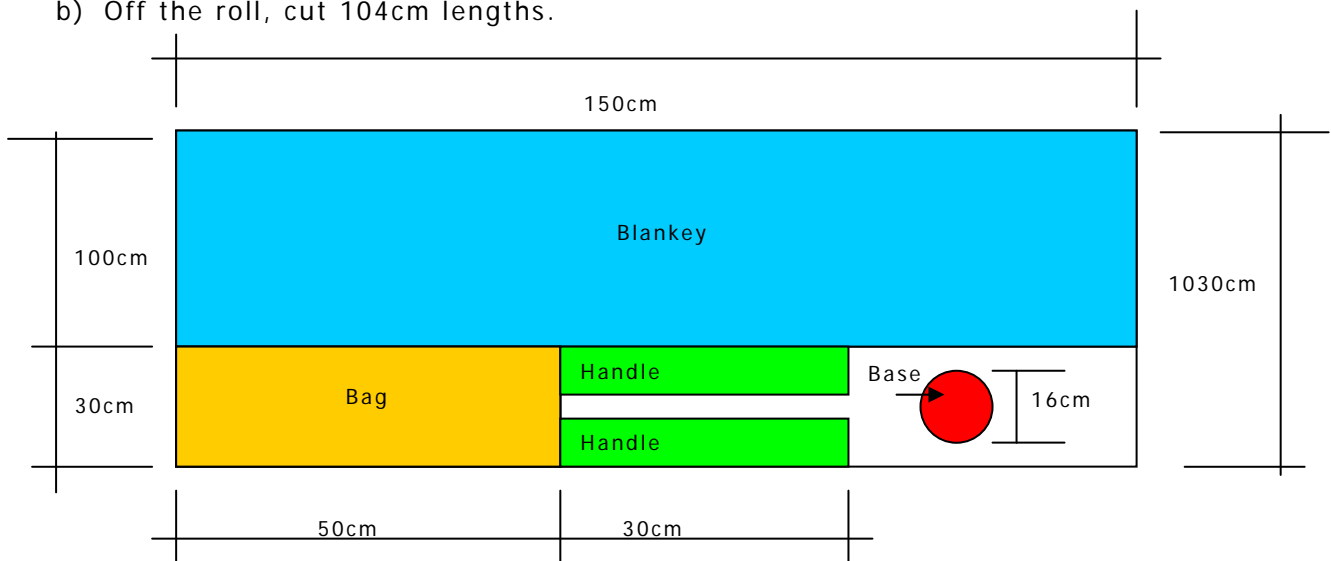
SPECIFICATIONS:

Designs available at Margaret's Designs

- Make templates from strong cardboard. Easier for accuracy.
- Use best quality Polar Fleece.
- Blankey (cutting size): 150cm long x 100cm wide – Cut off roll.
- Base size (cutting size): 16cm diameter - cut from template.
- 2 Handles (cutting size): Each handle 30cm long x 8cm wide – cut from template.
- Bag (cutting size): 50cm long x 30cm wide – cut from template.

MAKING THE BLANKEY:

- Fleece on a roll in the shop is usually 150cm wide.
- Off the roll, cut 104cm lengths.



- Round all corners of the blanket using the base template.
- Overlock the total Blankey surround.
- Embroider a design in one corner of the Blankey as shown below.



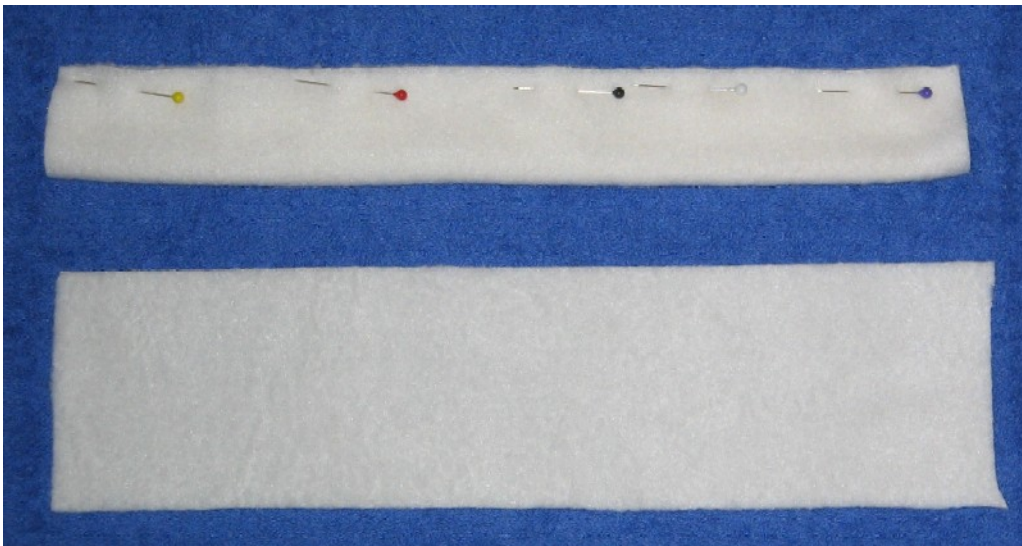
MAKING THE BAG:

- a) Using template, cut a rectangle 50cm x 30cm from the Polar fleece.
- b) Embroider a design in center. See picture.



MAKING THE HANDLES:

- a) Cut 2 handles 8cm wide x 30cm in length.
- b) Fold and sew as per picture.



ATTACHING HANDLES TO BAG:

- a) Mark center of bag and 11cm each side of the centreline attach handles as per picture below.
- b) Sew handles 1cm from top edge of bag.



ASSEMBLING BAG:

- a) Fold R/S together and stitch 2cm seam as shown in picture below.



c) Pin and stitch base to bag as per picture below.



d) Fold over and stitch a 2cm hem at the top of the bag as per picture below.



e) Turn Bag R/S out as per picture below.



f) Fold Blankey as per picture below.



g) Roll Blankey as per picture below.



h) Place Blankey in Bag, and " Geronimo" you have made the marvellous "Blankey in a bag", in an hour. Happy sewing.
