



EMBROIDERY INSTRUCTIONS & REQUIREMENTS FOR CD COASTER

MATERIALS:

- ❖ 2 Pieces **Felt 16cm x 16cm**, any colour of your choice
- ❖ 1 Piece **Avalon Plus 22cm x 25cm**
- ❖ 1 Piece of **Avalon (Plastic) 14cm x 14cm**
- ❖ Spray Adhesive (**This time it must be the spray glue!**)
- ❖ Old CD
- ❖ Double sided tape
- ❖ **1m** Narrow lace if required
- ❖ Embroidery design
- ❖ Embroidery and/or Metallic thread
- ❖ Embroidery and Sewing machine
- ❖ **Zipper foot**
- ❖ Embroidery and/or metallic needles as well as sewing needles
- ❖ **Pinking scissors** or wave cutter if required
- ❖ Usual embroidery and sewing equipment such as pins, scissors, marking pens, etc

EMBROIDERY AND CONSTRUCTION STEPS

- ❖ Hoop Avalon Plus in medium hoop (10cm x 10cm design)
- ❖ Mark centre point on felt and place on Avalon Plus
- ❖ Secure felt on Avalon Plus with double sided tape
- ❖ Place **Avalon** on top of felt, **securing with magic tape**

- ❖ Embroider design
- ❖ Remove from hoop and cut excess Avalon Plus away
- ❖ Spray the **shiny** side of the CD well with Spray Adhesive (**shiny side for the front of CD**)
- ❖ Position the centre point of the CD and the **centre point** of the felt to match and stick felt onto CD using a bit of pressure
- ❖ Spray the **label side** of the CD well with Spray Adhesive and stick 2nd piece of felt onto CD creating a '**sandwich**' with the CD between the 2 layers of felt
- ❖ Use the **zipper foot** of you sewing machine. This will allow you to sew as close as possible to the edge of the CD
- ❖ Stitch around the edge of the CD
- ❖ Lace can be sewn onto the finished edge if you want to, but **DON'T** cut the felt before the lace has been sewn on
- ❖ Cut excess lace away with pinking scissors or a wave cutter

NOTE: If a fabric is used instead of felt, you need to sew the cut edge with a close zigzag to stop the fabric from fraying

IF YOU JOIN SEVERAL CD'S TOGETHER, YOU CAN CREATE PLACEMATS OR CENTRE PIECES FOR HOT DISHES IN THE CENTRE OF THE TABLE

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
