This oven mitt fits the 127 x 178 mm (5 x 7 inches) and 100 x 130 mm (4 x 5 inches) hoop size. It is provided especially for the appliqué novice to prove how easy it is to do machine appliqué, especially when step by step visual instructions are given in this document.

Thread colors used will depend entirely on the appliqué fabric you choose, so I am simply going to number the colors and not give the actual color.

If you buy the set you will also get step by step instructions for making the wall hanging depicted at the end of this document.

	1	Oven mitt outline for appliqué fabric placements
	2	Tack down stitch for oven mitt
	3	Zigzag to secure main oven mitt appliqué fabric more firmly
	4	Satin stitch oven mitt outline
	5	Top of oven mitt decorative fill stitch

### **Appliqué instructions**

1. Stitch the first color, which is the placement line for the appliqué fabric.



2. Place your appliqué fabric over the demarcated area.



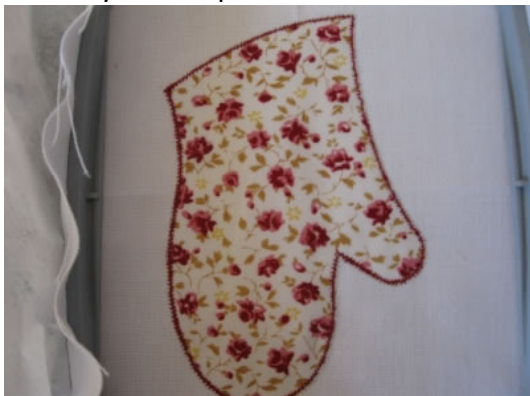
3. Hold it gently in place while you do the tack down stitch line.



4. Remove the hoop from the machine and carefully cut as closely as you dare to the outside of the stitching line.



5. Return your hoop to the machine and stitch the zigzag secure line.



6. Stitch the satin stitch oven mitt outline.



7. Finally stitch the decorative fill stitch at the top of the oven mitt.

**Your stitch out is complete!**
