

Quick Project

Embroidered Potholder



This a quicky project for yourself or as a gift. I found these potholders at Wal-Mart (2 for \$1.00) and they are perfect for this project. They are 6.75" wide X 8" long. The photo above shows the 5x7 design, so the 4x4 design will look a little different.

Here are the steps:

For best results, use the same thread on the bobbin as in the top.

Hoop 2 layers of Sulky water soluble stabilizer or Vilene.



I prefer the Sulky or transparent stabilizer for this project. If you use Vilene, it will have to soak longer to remove it.

Spray the stabilizer lightly with temporary spray adhesive, such as Sulky KK2000 and place the potholder on top.



When the design is complete, remove excess stabilizer and dampen the back to remove the rest. Depending on what type of stabilizer you use, you may need to soak your potholder to remove all of the stabilizer. The great thing is that it will end up being a reversible project!
