

EO915-Christmas is Coming

Here's a fun Christmas Ornament set to fit the 4x4 hoop, with 3 choices of each design, first one is a regular filled in pattern, the other two are ornaments for the tree with a background layer as well as one without.

THESE ARE NOT STAND-ALONE DECORATIONS. Hooping Instructions for the ornaments,

1st option:

Hoop 1 or 2 layers of wash-away stabilizer with 1 layer of Crinoline Tulle so that the patterns are actually sewn over the tulle. When they are sewn out trim as close to the edge as possible without cutting the threads. Soak them for a few seconds in hot water and let dry. When dry trim any loose edge stitches being very careful not to cut the satin stitch outline. If they are not laying flat, Iron between 2 pieces of fabric or paper so the starch doesn't get on your iron.

2nd option:

Hoop 1 layer of crinoline lace and 1 layer of lace so that the patterns sew over both layers. Since you are not using wash-away there is no need to soak them, but if not stiff enough spray starch and let dry. Iron stiff, you can add several layers of starch depending on how stiff you want them.

If you like some sparkle to your ornaments using a glue stick put glue where you want some sparkle and sprinkle some glitter over the glue area. You can also take a sharpie the same colour as the ornament edge and colour around any lace/tulle that shows.

The individual patterns that are not in ornaments hangers can be sewn out on any article of clothing or Christmas décor you choose. You can also use an ornament hook and hang them on the tree too.

The colour choices on the sheet are from the brothers extended list but the actual sew-out colours are your choice.
