Garden Pearl's Sampler

Sampler designs for eyelits or 3 (three) mm hot fix crystals

- *These designs were designed as eyelits so additional color stops were added for the best stitch out of the final design.*
- *Tested using 1 sheet of fabric like wss for eyelits, cutaway for regular stitching ,low fray fabric, muslin was used.*
- *Use 12 point needle and bobbin thread,*
- *Designs were created with Embird and were sewn on Kenmore 19001 4x4 hoop, tested in sew format.*
- *Do not resize these designs in any way, as you will loose stitch quality.*

**Tip: It is recommended that you clean your bobbin area and replace your needle often. Start with a fresh needle.*

Gather your Supplies

Thread , bobbins, needles, pins, small scissors, rotary cutter and mat, fabric, water soluble stabilizer , or cutaway, clear wss for topping if needed, wss fabric pen if needed, 1/8 eyelit cutter and small self healing mat.


- *If you are sewing designs for eyelits, hoop fabric like wss along with your fabric*
- *If you are sewing designs for crystals, hoop medium wt cutaway stabelizer with your fabric, skipping punching*
- *Add basting stitches if necessary.*

7 colors*

- *Eyelit outlining and lettering color.....*
- *Remove hoop and punch eyelits if desired...*
- *Leaf Stitching (right side)*
- *Flowers (right side)*
- *Wicking in yellow*
- *Leaf Stitching (left side)*
- *Flower (right side)*
- *Eyelit (left side)*
