

Free Coaster



Requirements:

Fabric – I have tested these out using 100% quilting fabrics. **Pre-wash all fabrics.**

Stabilizer – Solvy Vilene or your preferred water-soluble stabilizer.

Batting/Wadding/Pellon – I have used a few different thicknesses from 3 to 8mm and all worked great.

Thread – I have used 40 & 50 wt embroidery thread, but you could use any thread of your choice. I have included extra colour changes to give you more flexibility with your project. You can do these all 1 colour, or do the quilting stitching a different colour. It is your choice what to use in the bobbin. For the satin stitching, I used the same thread as I used on the top, but for the quilting, you can use the same colour as your bottom fabric or use, the same as the top so you can see the quilting stitches.

The use of a fabric glue stick can help keep the fabrics flat while stitching.

Cutting:

Fabric & Batting – I used two different fabrics, a patterned for the front and a plain for the back. Cut 2 pieces of fabric 110mm x 110mm (4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square, plus one from batting.

PLEASE take the time to read all instructions prior to stitching.

	
Hoop up Solvy. Have all fabric & Pellon cut to size.	1. Colour 1 ~ Stitches the guideline on the stabilizer for placing fabric and Pellon.



2. Place fabric 1 (right side down) Batting, then fabric 2 (right side up) over the top of the guideline stitching as shown.



3. **Colour 2** ~ Stitches down fabric & batting, use a stylus to keep fabric in place. Pin if you need to.



4. Remove hoop from machine. Trim away the excess fabric close to the stitching line.
~ **DO NOT REMOVE FROM HOOP** ~



5. **Colour 3** ~ Stitches any quilting or fancy stitches.



6. **Colour 4** ~ Satin stitches edge.



7. Trim away Solvy. Rinse in warm water and lay flat to dry.
