

Instructions to stitch the Tassel Flowers

- 1) Hoop your fabric together with 2 layers wash away stabiliser like Avalon plus or stitch n Tear.
- 2) First stitch the leaves
- 3) When you come to stitch the fringe flower float a separate piece of stitch n Tear underneath the hoop. This makes the cutting of the bobbin thread easier.
- 4) ALSO lay a piece of plastic Avalon (wash away stabiliser) on top of the material on the stitching area of the flowers. This will help you not to damage the scrolls and leaves under the flowers when you pull the thread to the top,
- 5) Stitch the flowers.
- 6) When you're done unhoop your design,
- 7) At the back of the flowers, CAREFULLY cut only through the bobbin thread all around the flower.

- 9) Then on the front, with a blunt object like a tweezer carefully pull the satin stitches of the flowers to the front to form the fringe effect.

- 11) Do not stitch this fringe designs on items that are going to be laundered frequently.
