

## *Instructions - Face Mask – Option a*

Design Size	Outside Fabric	Inside Fabric	Side “tab” fabric	Elastic 3 or 6 mm	Finished size w x h
Small – a	5" x 5"	5" x 5"	4 x (1½" x 3")	7"	61.5 x 144.3 mm 2.4" x 5.7"
Medium – a	6¼" x 6"	6¼" x 6"	4 x (1½" x 4")	8"	80.4 x 178.4 mm 2" x 7"
Large - a	7⅞" x 8"	7⅞" x 8"	4 x (1¾" x 4½")	7½"	100.4 x 208.7 mm 4" x 8.2"

Play around with fabrics with option a!

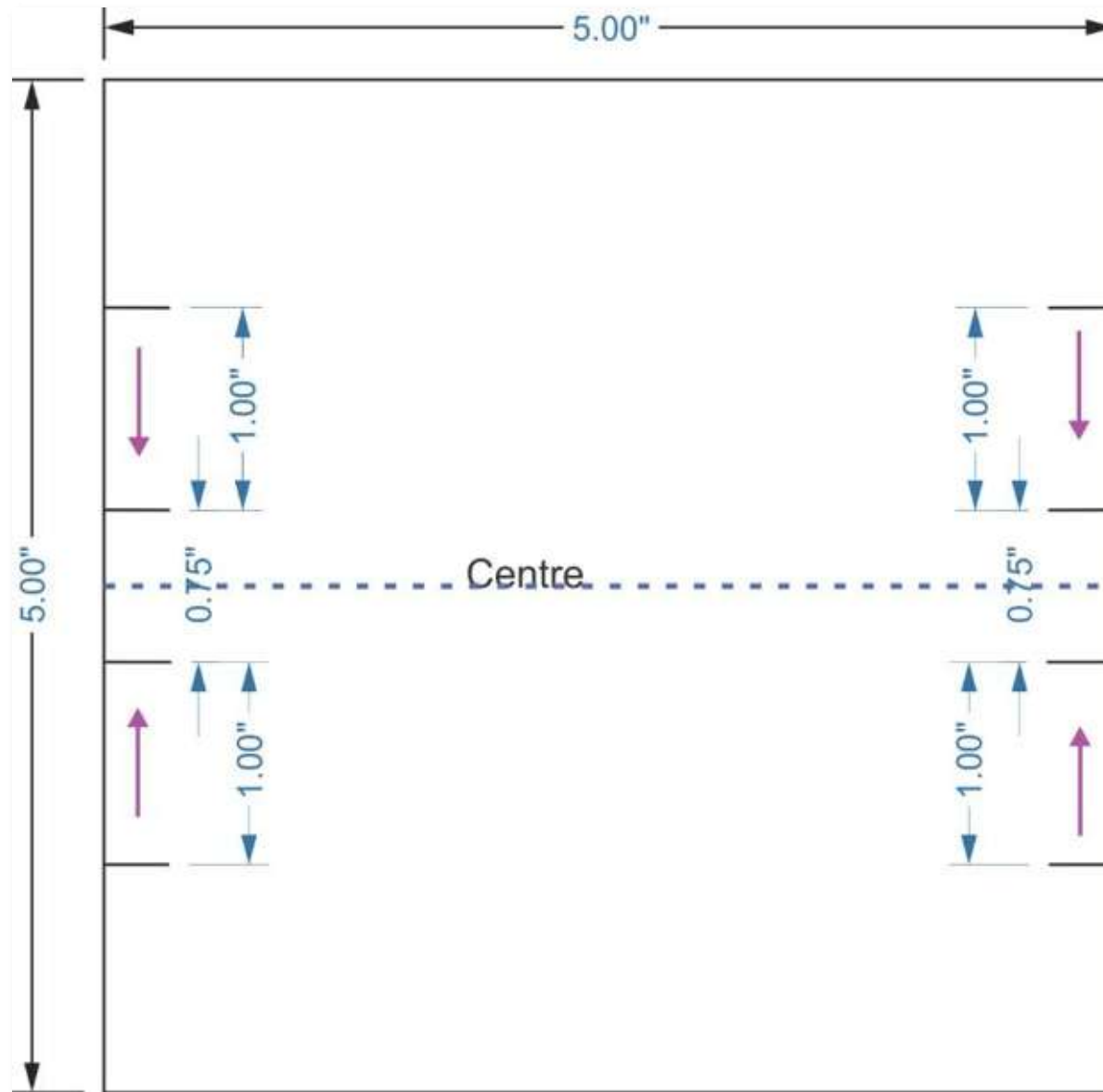
### **Preparation**

Cut all fabric pieces for the desired size and option. Place inside and outside fabric together and mark folding location as shown below. If you want to do the inside and outside separate you can – there is 2 stitch down stitches in the design – colors 2 & 3.



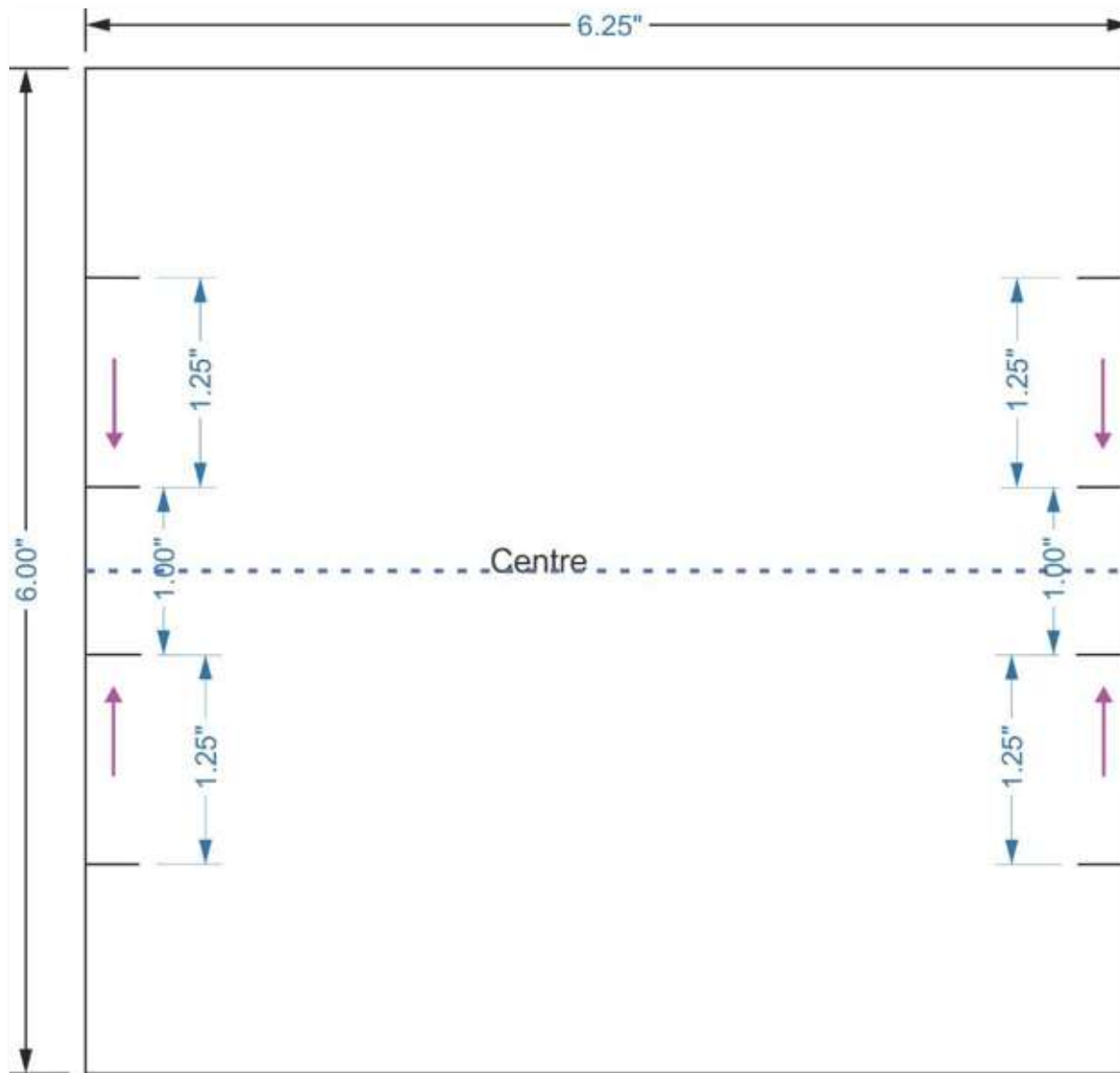

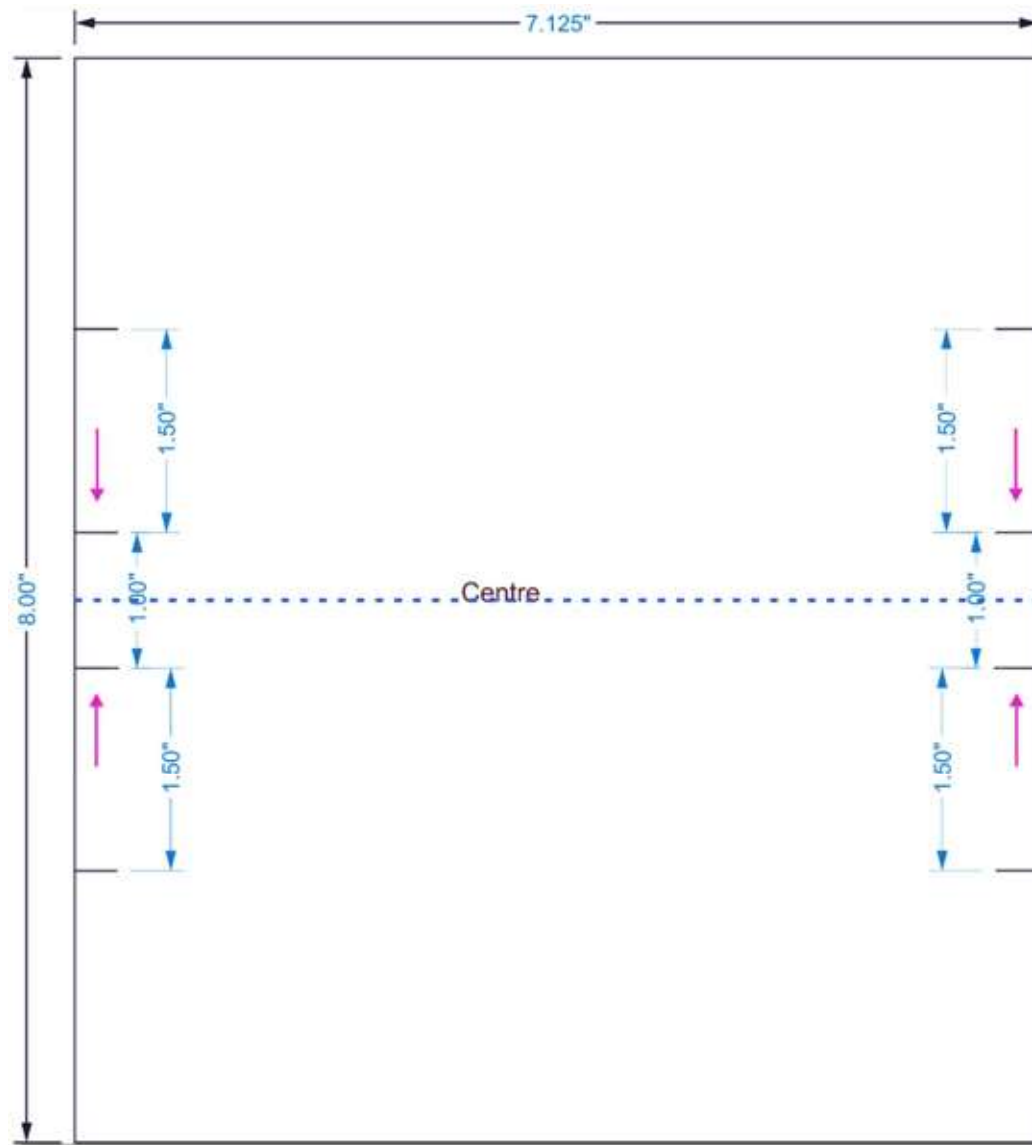

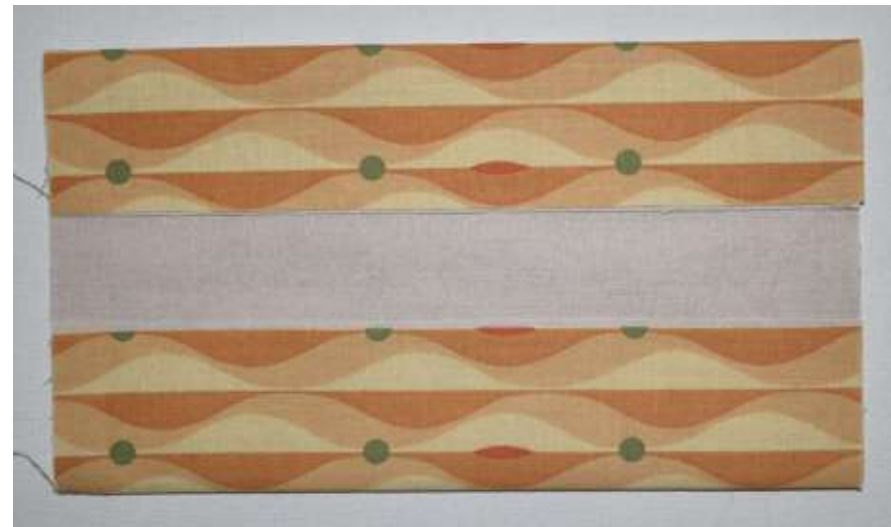

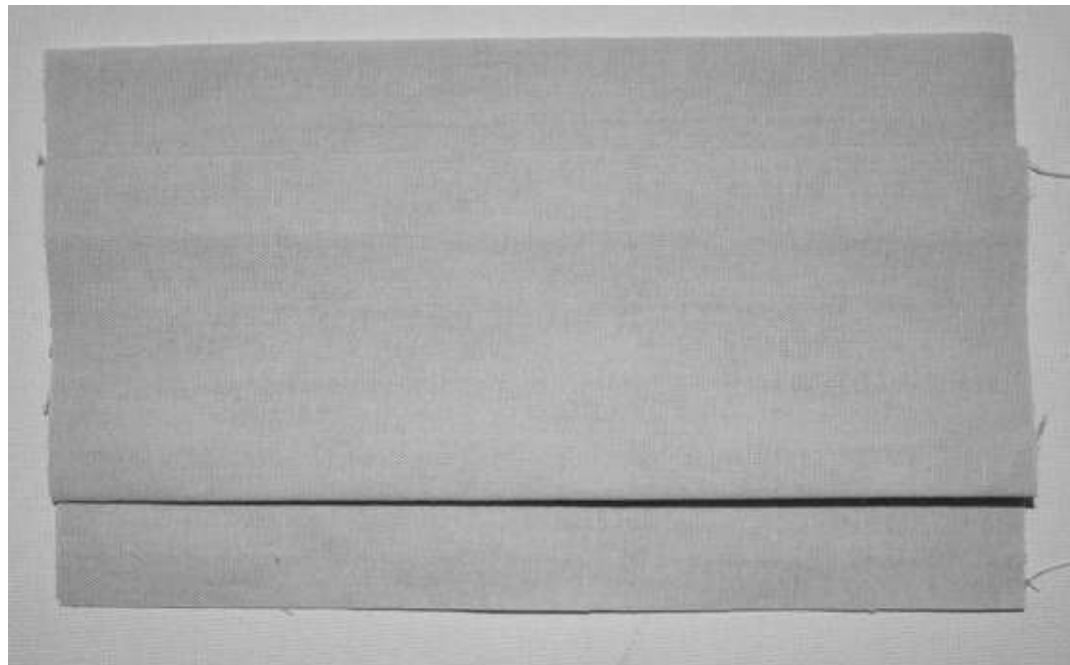
Mark Fabric



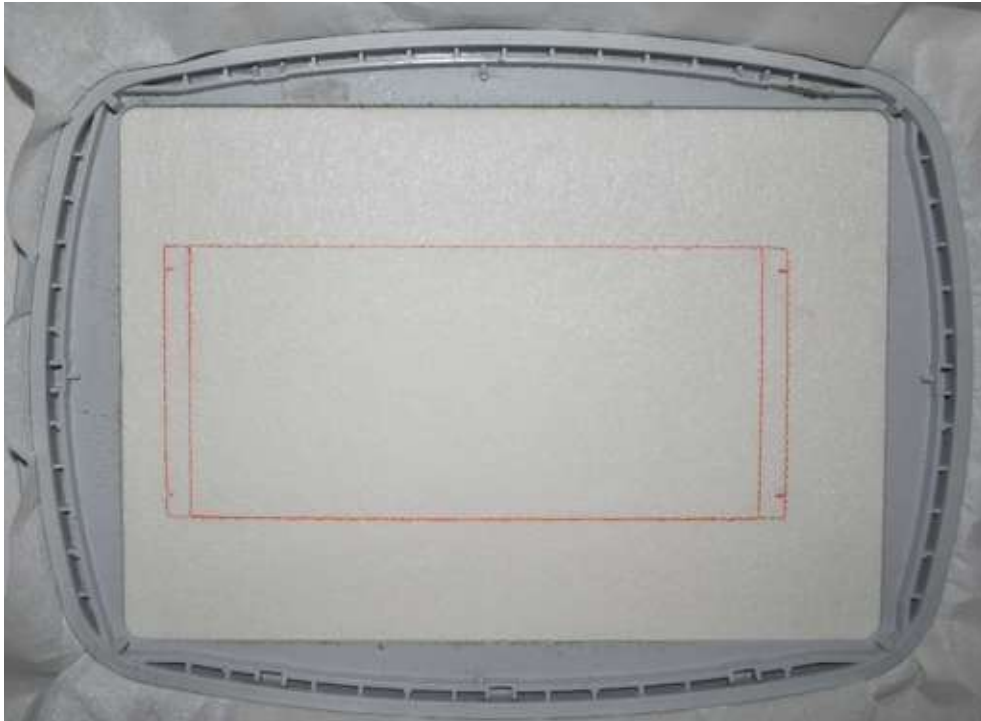
Fold top and bottom and iron flat.



Match just folded edge with remaining markers as shown below with the black arrow (fold towards center) and iron. I have used pins to hold these folds in place.



1. Hoop tearaway or wash away stabilizer. Stitch color 1 – this is a placement line.





2. Place folded fabric inside placement line as shown.

Recommend using a topping if you don't have a spring-loaded embroidery foot to prevent the embroidery foot from "catching" the folded fabric. Other option is to adjust the height of your embroidery foot.

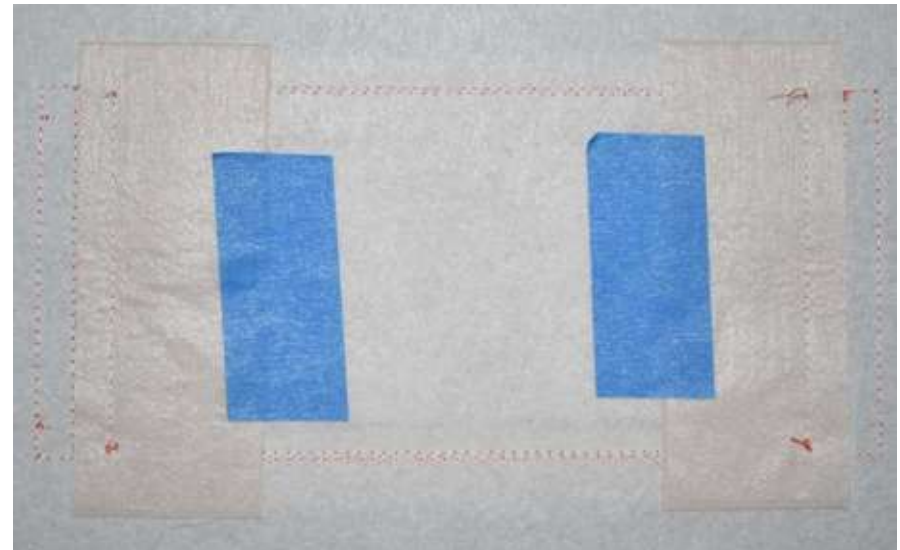
Keep fabric in place with tape (My tape was running low so I used mostly pins, just be careful to keep pins out of the needles way!)

Color 2 and 3 is the same stitching if you want to separately stitch down the inside and outside fabric or add another layer. If stitching the inside and outside fabric together skip color 3.

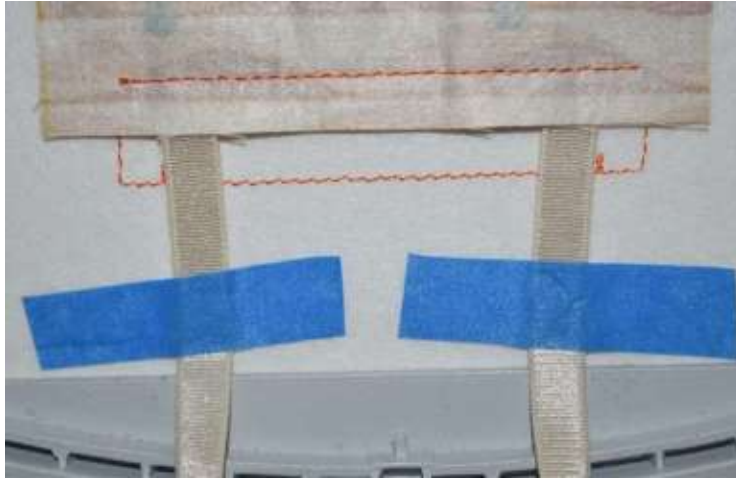




3. Place side strips to match the inner placement line on front and back of hoop, both sides and stitch color 4 & 5 to hold fabric in place.



4. Place elastic to match the markers as shown below and keep in place with tape. Elastic length is just a guide and can be changed to match the persons face you are making it for. The length of the elastic for small size was fitted on a 10yr old boy, the medium on a lady and the large on a man.



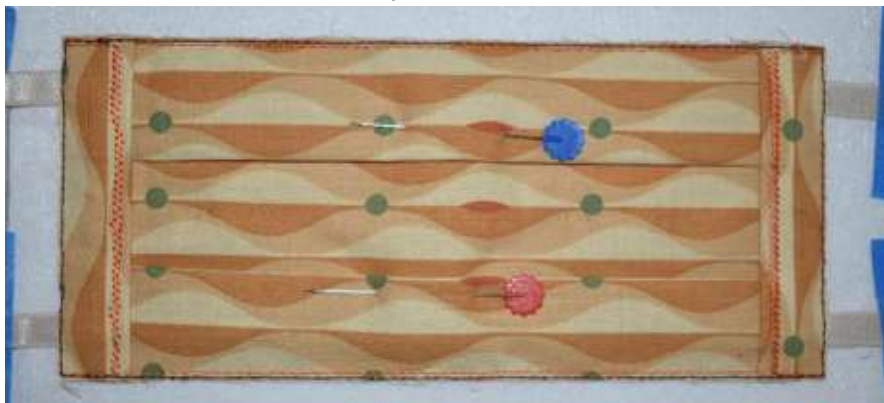
Fold side strips over and finger press and tape to keep in place both sides of hoop



Change bobbin thread to be the same as top thread. Stitch color 6 to keep side fabric in place and for decoration.



5. Stitch color 7 - Remove hoop from machine and trim fabric close to the stitch line, taking care not to cut the elastic.





6. Stitch color 8, satin stitch, to finish the facemask.
