







Charming Heart Coaster

Alphabet Instructions

Also for Australia Coaster

Color		
1	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Load design into embroidery machine. 2. Hoop tearaway, wash away or soft cutaway stabiliser. Depending on the weight of the wash away 2 layers may be required. (illustration shows cutaway). For tearaway float extra piece underneath. 3. Prepare fabric to be used. Cut fabric 1 inch bigger than the design size. Depending on your preference apply batting or wadding or Sew Lazy Stiff Stuff or Pellon Peltex fusible to the front fabric. I recommend applying a light interfacing to the wrong side of the back fabric. 4. Stitch color 1 – This is a placement line for the front fabric. 	 
2	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Place the front fabric over the placement line. Secure with tape or temporary adhesive spray to keep in place. 6. Stitch color 2 to hold down the front fabric. 	

<p>Design colors</p> <p>3-7</p>	<p>7. Stitch colors 3 to 7 to complete design – color 7 optional (I have excluded color 7 in my test stitch).</p> <p>Colors 3 to 5 for Australia coaster</p>	
<p>8</p>	<p>8. Remove hoop from machine and place back fabric under the hoop – secure with tape or temporary adhesive spray to keep in place.</p> <p>9. Stich color 8 to secure back fabric – this is also a cutting line.</p> <p>Color 6 for Australia coaster</p> <p>10. Remove hoop from machine a cut the front and back fabric about 1mm from the stitched outline.</p>	
<p>9-10</p>	<p>11. Place same thread in bobbin as top.</p> <p>12. Stich color 9 – satin stitch to finish off the coaster.</p> <p>13. Optional – stitch color 10 as additional decoration over the satin stitch.</p> <p>Remove design from hoop and tear away or cut away the stabiliser or in the case of wash away cut close to the edge of the design and remove excess stabaliser with a wet sponge</p>	<p>Colors 7 and 8 for Australia Coaster</p>  <p>These pictures are based on my test stitch out – the font was changed for the final design.</p>

Spray the Mug Rug on both sides 3 times with fabric protect spray – let it dry well each time before next application. This will protect it and reduce the need for washing too often.



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
