Color Sequence by description: 1. Tan (bat), 2. Brown (glove), 3. White (Ball and Shoe elements), 4. Deep Red (shoe), 5. Gray (Sole of shoe outline), 6. Black (Outline and ball elements)

Use cutaway stabilizer when stitching on clothing. 2 layers of a good, sturdy stabilizer is recommended on the backside.

When stitching on non-wearable items you may use tearaway or WSS (Water Soluble Stabilizer) if desired. Again, two layers is recommended. If stitching on fabric with a pile such as terry cloth or sweat-shirt fabric use one layer of WSS on the top.

The color chart used is Isacord but feel free to choose your own thread and color scheme.
