I created this design for my son who loves to cook and got his own apartment for the first time. Then I put it on a banner for him to hang in his kitchen.

Use cutaway stabilizer when stitching on clothing. 2 layers of a good, sturdy stabilizer is recommended on the backside.

When stitching on non-wearable items you may use tearaway or WSS (Water Soluble Stabilizer) if desired. Again, two layers is recommended. If stitching on fabric with a pile such as terry cloth or sweat-shirt fabric use one layer of WSS on the top.

The color chart used is Isacord 40 but feel free to choose your own thread and color scheme.
