

APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS

1. "APPLIQUE POSITION" is a straight guide stitch to indicate where to place your fabric for the appliqué.
2. Place fabric over the indicated area.
3. "APPLIQUE FABRIC" then sews the fabric down.
4. Cut away the excess fabric without removing the embroidery from the hoop.
5. Continue with the embroidery of the design.

Use the same colour for the "APPLIQUE POSITION" and "APPLIQUE FABRIC" to co-ordinate with colour of fabric used for appliqué.

Bohemian Quilt Block 6

6 inches: 149.4 x 150.0mm (5.88 x 5.91"); 17 214 Stitches

7 inches: 179.9 x 180.0mm (7.08 x 7.09"); 24 465 Stitches

8 inches: 200.0 x 199.6mm (7.87 x 7.86"); 27 105 Stitches

14 Thread Changes

Marathon Rayon colours listed

1. Hoop background fabric (Yellow) and pin batting to the back of the hoop.
2. Colour 1: APPLIQUE POSITION centre piece. (White) *White 1179*
3. Colour 2: APPLIQUE FABRIC with co-ordinating thread. *White 1179*
4. Remove hoop from machine and trim fabric around centre piece.
5. Colour 3: FINAL OUTLINE of centre piece. *Black 1180*
6. Colour 4: *Christy Blue 1197*
7. Colour 5: *Black 1180*
8. Colour 6: *White 1179*
9. Colour 7: *Black 1180*
10. Colour 8: *White 1179*
11. Colour 9: *Black 1180*
12. Colour 10: *White 1179*
13. Colour 11: *Black 1180*
14. Colour 12: *White 1179*
15. Colour 13: *Black 1180*
16. Add backing to the back of the embroidery.
17. Colour 14: Stitch outline of block in coordinating colour.
18. Cut ¼" from Colour 14 to allow for seam allowance.

Digitizing was done in sections to allow you to embroider a more colourful block should you choose to.
