

Lace Eggs 5



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
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These designs are free standing. Use your favourite water soluble stabilizer. I used three layers of Solvy or one layer of Vilene and Marathon or Sulky threads. After embroidering the design, soak it in the water but not too long to keep some stiffness, otherwise your lace won't look really nice. Lay it flat on towel or between two towels or soft material, iron while it is still a little bit damp. DO NOT use ultrathin bobbin thread.




