### Dragon Patch

**5.12x7.03**

**43862 Stitches**

**Placement Line**-Use a color that matches your fabric or the color you want the finished satin stitch boarder to have. Make sure your fabric over laps the placement line.

**Tack down Line**-Use the same color as the Placement Line. Once the Tack down Line has sewn out remove the hoop from your machine, place on a flat surface and trim the fabric as close to the Tack down Line as you can get. Once the fabric has been trimmed return the hoop to your machine and finish sewing out the dragon.

For the Metallic thread change your needle to a metallic needle and slow down your machine

Gold Metallic

For the next color change back to your regular embroidery needle and restore the speed for your machine.

Be sure all jump threads are clipped before sewing out the Deep Green as it is the outline and will make any jump threads very difficult to trim.

Deep Green 1293

Red 2045 Polly thread If you use a red metallic thread be sure to change your needle to a metallic needle and slow down your machine.

Gold Metallic If you used the Polly red you will want to change your needle to a metallic needle and slow down your machine for this gold metallic thread.

**Finish Satin Stitch** – Is your choice of color. If you are using a regular thread, be sure to change back to the regular needle and restore the speed of your machine.
